Description: See Section II. Missions to Women; **Part 1** is devoted to the original manuscript records of the Society for Promoting Female Education (FES) in China, India and the East, 1834-1899. These provide a detailed record of the interaction between Western and Eastern women in India, China and other Asian countries. The papers throw much light on life in closed female communities in Asia and on the status of women in such a gender dominated society. The papers also document the lives of the many women missionaries involved. **Part 2** brings together a complete run of the detailed, bi-monthly Zenana periodical *India's Women and China's Daughters*, 1880-1939 which then continues as *Looking East at India's Women and China's Daughters*, 1940-1957. **Part 3** covers *Homes of the East*, 1910-1948 (including *Torchbearer* from 1914), *Daybreak*, 1889, 1893-1894 and 1906-1909, and *The Indian Female Evangelist*, 1872-1880. **Part 4:** *The Indian Female Evangelist* and successors, 1881-1956. *The Indian Female Evangelist* for January 1881-October 1893 was published by the Zenana, Medical and Bible Mission. In November 1893 the periodical changed its name to *The Zenana: or, Woman's Work in India* and from September 1936 it changed its name to *The Zenana: Women's Work in India and Pakistan*.

Mary Robinsons Sappho and Phaeon (1796) show how these classical works continued to exert a powerful influence over writers.
