The San Diego/Tijuana Economic Review is the premier source of information about the cross-border economies of the San Diego/Tijuana Metropolitan Region, which includes San Diego, Tijuana, Tecate and Rosarito, and the Mexicali Metropolitan Region, which includes Mexicali and Imperial County. This quarterly publication is produced by San Diego Dialogue at the University of California, San Diego, and El Colegio de la Frontera Norte in Tijuana. It tracks and analyzes basic measures of the regional economies and their relationship to economic development for both regions of the Baja California/California border.

The Review includes data on employment by sector, unemployment, gross regional product, new building permits, population, retail sales, border crossings, tourism and regional imports and exports.

Economic analysts, planners, and business analysts can access the Review's extensive data collection on disk by becoming members of the Review's Forum. In addition to the quarterly Review, Forum members receive the data on disk monthly, an accompanying newsletter, and tickets for Economic Review events, including the annual Outlook Breakfast, held in November.
